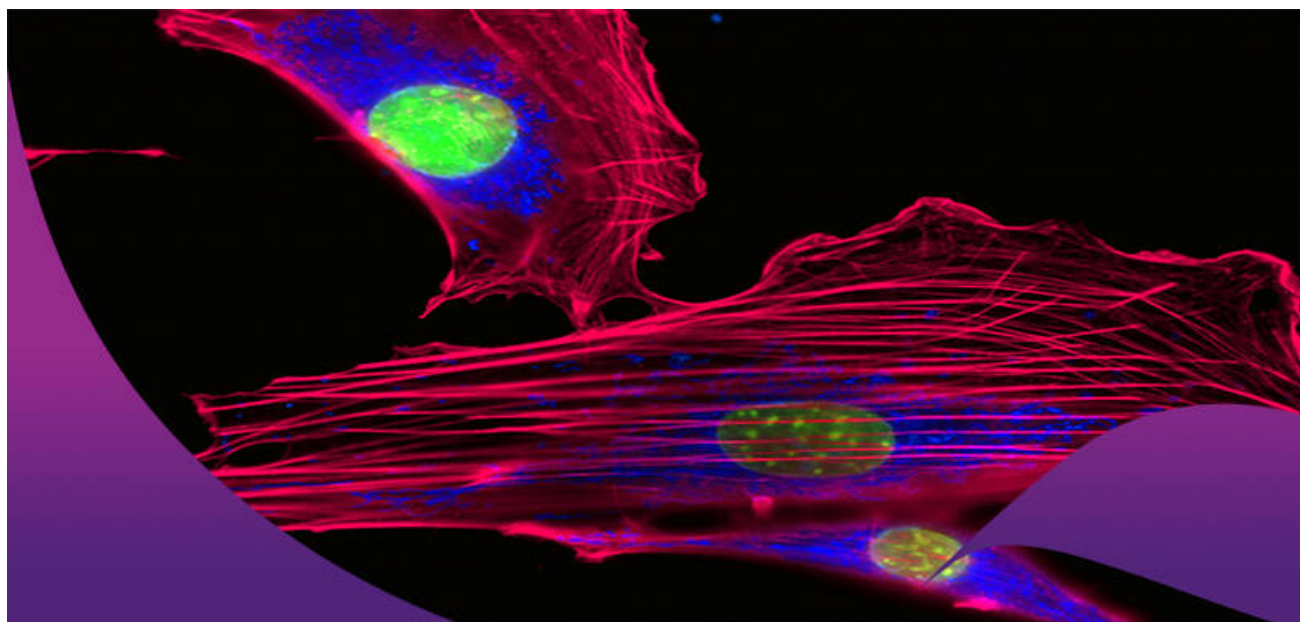




Australian Inflammation Centres 2022 Symposium
